



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between

and
WEICHAI POWER CO LTD



This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into as of 28th of April 2017, by and between Politeknik Perkapalan Negeri Surabaya and Weichai Power Co Ltd .

WHEREAS Politeknik Perkapalan Negeri Surabaya, is a state vocational education institution located at Jalan Teknik Kimia, ITS Campus, Keputih Sukolilo, Surabaya 60111.

WHEREAS Weichai Power Co Ltd is a leading engine manufacturer in China, its Indonesia branch located at Griya Sinta 7th floor, Tomang Raya No. 39, Jakarta Barat.

This memorandum of understanding sets out the background, purpose, agreements between the parties, the roles and responsibilities of signatories to this memorandum and the administrative arrangements.

1. Purpose of the Agreement

RECOGNIZING the mutual interest in the fields of education, research, training and development and dissemination of knowledge.

CONSIDERING the importance of collaboration between education institution and industry to ensure the technology and knowledge used in education institution are in line with industrial needs.

THE PARTIES HEREBY agree to establish collaboration according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder.

2. Areas of The Collaboration

The general purpose of this MOU is to facilitate academic and research cooperation between the parties here under based upon the principles of mutual benefit and may include the following general cooperation areas:

1. Machine donation from WEICHAI for academic purpose
2. Expert teaching in Campus
3. Assistance for curriculum development
4. Promoting of academic/industrial cooperation as mutually agreed

3. Conditions

Both parties agree that collaborative efforts herein do not represent obligation by either party. Both parties agree that:

- Nothing in this agreement shall be binding on the participating institutions
- All activities must be mutually agreed by both parties before initiation of activity.

4. Roles and Responsibilities

- a. Both parties agree to work together with reasonableness and honesty of purpose to establish and maintain a relationship of mutual benefit based on cooperation and partnership.
- b. Both parties recognize this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended with the consent of both Parties.
- c. Confidentiality
No party shall comment publicly on any matter that relates or indirectly to policies, practices or procedures of the other party with respect to this Memorandum of Understanding without first consulting and/or discussing with the other party.

5. Duration

This MOU may be modified by mutual written consent. The Agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years. It shall be renewed upon mutual written agreement. This agreement may be terminated by either side at 6 months written notice.
