



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
Between
SURABAYA SHIPBUILDING STATE POLITECHNIC,
INDONESIA
and
PALESTINE TECHNICAL COLLEGE- ARROUB,
PALESTINE



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is drawn up and agreed upon to further establish the cooperation between the Surabaya Shipbuilding State Polytechnic (hereinafter referred to as SSSP) located at Keputih Sukolilo – Surabaya, Indonesia, and Palestine Technical Collage Arroub (hereinafter referred to as PCTA), located at North Hebron , Palestine.

Surabaya Shipbuilding State Polytechnic or SSSP (Bahasa Indonesia : Politeknik Perkapalan Negeri Surabaya) is a public university in Surabaya, East Java, Indonesia, focused on the higher vocational education in shipbuilding process and the technology that support marine industry. Occupying a large area totaling 10 hectares as its main campus in Sukolilo, an area in the vicinity of East Surabaya, not only does SSSP provide advantages for both excellent engineering activities and pleasant natural life environment, but it also has a very friendly atmosphere and enormous community spirit.

Palestine Technical Collage Arroub or PTCA is one of five public colleges distributed in five different cities in Palestine, focuses on technical and vocational education. It has five major departments, banking and financial sciences, software and database, Arts and Information, Technology education and Multimedia systems. PTCA offers training for local community in fields related to the market core. Continuously develop the trainees to achieve a better quality of graduates. It continuously conducts infrastructure development to keep pace with the changing needs of technical education.

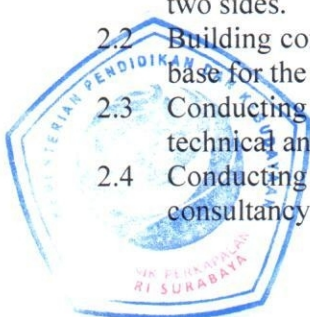
ARTICLE I: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Extension of MoU is to enable further cooperation between SSSP and PTCA for establishing collaborative relations between the two institutions to promote friendship and to cooperate in a mutually beneficial association. The core of cooperation should be within the field in technical and vocational education.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE

The scope of activities under this MoU is through such activities or programs related to but not limited to:

- 2.1 Building an enhanced and common understanding for technical and vocational education in the two sides.
- 2.2 Building common road map for technical and vocational training education which represents a base for the future degrees in the two sides.
- 2.3 Conducting a deep study about the both side's technical requirements to be excellent in technical and vocational education and fill these requirements.
- 2.4 Conducting joint training programs: develop institutional capacity building including joint consultancy and research programs, and joint centers of excellence;



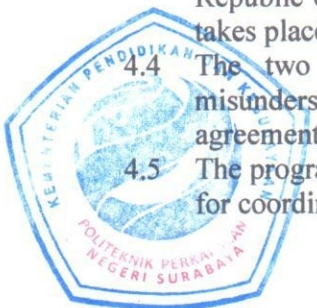
- 2.5 Unified International Bachelor Degree Program;
- 2.6 Graduate and Postgraduate scholarships in the field of technical and vocational education in the same two partners in according to the availability in both sides.
- 2.7 Faculty and staff exchange programs: human resource development through education, training, staff exchange and sabbaticals, including Adjunct Professorship in all the relevant fields and specialties;
- 2.8 Undertaking joint courses and professional programs through mutually agreeable arrangements such as launching of SSSP programs or campus at PTCA or joint phased programs at PTCA and SSSP;
- 2.9 Establishing two integrated centers of Excellency which use the same resources and provide access to shared online learning objects in both sides (SSSP and PTCA). These centers should have videoconferences to conduct periodic meetings between the academic and administrative staff in the two parties. At the same time it could be used for attending classes from abroad.
- 2.10 Joint organization of International Workshops, Conferences, Seminars and Symposia focusing on Science and Technology development in the region;
- 2.11 Facilitating the transfer of innovation and technology in the areas of mutual interest;
- 2.12 Supporting the infrastructure development which matches the new innovative and new degrees.
- 2.13 Supporting researchers in both parts and encouraging them to conduct publishable researches related mainly to the technical and vocational education.

ARTICLE III: DURATION, TERMINATION, AND AMENDMENT

- 3.1 This MoU will be effective from the date of signing by both parties up to a period of five (5) years, and may be subject to extensions by mutual consent of the parties in writing.
- 3.2 Either party may terminate this MoU by giving six (6) months advance notice in writing to the other party.
- 3.3 The provisions of this MoU may be amended at any time with the mutual consent of the Parties in writing.
- 3.4 The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination, and expiration unless otherwise agreed upon between the parties.

ARTICLE IV: SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- 4.1 Each party will consult with and take approval of the other party to use the latter's name, the names of the latter's officials/faculty members, and the logo for the activities under this MoU, and dissemination of results, on a case-by-case basis.
- 4.2 Modalities of each type of collaboration, associated activities and financial aspects shall be mutually agreed upon on a case-by-case basis in separate Memorandum of Agreements (MoA).
- 4.3 This MoU shall be governed and construed under the laws of the Palestinian authority and the Republic of Indonesia as appropriate depending upon where the activity under this agreement takes place.
- 4.4 The two parties will consult with each other and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.
- 4.5 The program coordinators (Dr. Mat Syai'in and Dr. Nidal A.M. Jabari) are the only responsible for coordinating, organizing and managing the whole period of the project until completing it.
